





Visual 32: Trust in governments is at an historic low





Visual 33: Interpersonal trust levels have decreased




Visual 34: Global trade has hit a bump in the road

Visual 35: Global trade is following a slower growth path today





Visual 37: The German export engine remains powerful





Visual 38: The political climate seems to harvest ‘strong man’ leaders








Visual 40: Democrats and Republicans live in different world
